Message from Rabbi Norm Roman

"(Some of the) Things to Know About our High Holy Day Services 5874"

As I compose this message, Rosh HaShana is only about 3 weeks away! There is still much to do – research, preparations, outlines, Festival melodies to learn, and last, but certainly not least, the personal reflection, repentance and desire-to-improve that our sacred Tradition imposes upon us for this time of year.

In addition to the more practical, necessary information being provided to you, and with the sincere hope that you will be able to join us for some if not all of our Worship and Holy Day experiences at BSTC this year, here are some other things to know:

I am especially excited and proud to welcome our daughter, Caryn Roman, as Vocal/Cantorial Soloist, joining me on the Bimah. For those of you who have not met her, Caryn is a full-time Jewish Educator in Brooklyn and Manhattan. Her Bachelor's Degree in Communications was earned at Boston University, and she also has been granted two Master's Degrees: in Non-Profit Management from New York University and in Jewish Religious Education from the Hebrew Union College – Jewish Institute of Religion (where she now also serves on the Faculty). She has assisted in leading High Holy Day Services at several Congregations and college-campus Hillel Foundations in the New Jersey and New York area, and is a highly qualified Song Leader and Soloist.

also Shabbat, and because we will be offering an (informal) second day Service on Sunday morning, we are honoring the tradition of not sounding the Shofar on Saturday; nor will we be including Avinu Malkeinu (I will explain why during our Service). However, Mike Finkelstein, our Shofarist-par-excellence, and I will record the entire Shofar liturgy in advance. *Should you wish to remain in the Sanctuary on Saturday after the regular Worship concludes, we will play the recording then for those who do want to hear the Ram's Horn that day. Or, of course, you can watch the recording at home, at any time. The full Shofar Service will be included on Sunday morning, as will the singing of Avinu Malkeinu.*

Please consider joining us at our Tashlich Ritual on Rosh HaShana Afternoon at Sahuarita Lake Park, and at our annual Kever Avot Memorial Service, to be held in the Jewish Section of the Green Valley Cemetery (on LaCanada Road) on Friday morning, September 22nd.

Last year, I introduced a new program for Yom Kippur Afternoon – a Symposium of 3 Temple members who have been invited to share their unique, “Jewish Journeys”, histories, and insights into their personal connections to our Community. Please come to hear their stories; our Speakers for 2023/5784 will be Ingeborg MacDonald, Gary Melton and Fran Orrok.

And finally, a very personal and meaningful request: it is one of my customs to end the Yizkor Memorial Service on Yom Kippur by not only listing the names of those of our family and friends who have died during the past year, but also to announce the names of any and all babies who have been born or adopted into our families during the past year. *In other words, we go from the sadness of death to the joyfulness of life! Please notify me or Stacy in the BSTC Office with any name that should be included.*

With an expression of deep appreciation to the BSTC Leadership, Ritual and Hospitality Committees, the Men's Club and the Sisterhood, as well as to my wife Lynne and our family – we wish you all: L'Shana Tova Tikateivu – May you be inscribed for a good, sweet. Healthy and peaceful New Year!
