Message from Rabbi Norm Roman

Friends,

When you read this, Lynne and I will be somewhere in the middle of the Pacific Ocean, enjoying some "down-time" on a cruise ship. Every once in a while, I have the opportunity to serve as Rabbi/Chaplain on board – conducting Sabbath Services (and Festivals if they're on the calendar), as well as presenting lectures about Jewish subjects, participating in respectful dialogue with the Christian Clergy, and being available for pastoral support, should any of the passengers request it of me. There will be plenty of time for relaxing and reading (I'm taking 7 books with me!), as well as touring a part of the world which will be totally new to us. I hope to return to Green Valley with my batteries re-charged!

For this year, and this Winter, have been challenging for many of us. There have been illnesses, hospitalizations and deaths, professional disappointments, increased tensions and worries about Israel, Anti-Semitism and the future of our own country. I always have moments of sadness mixed with loving memories at this season – my parents, of blessed memory, died within 16 days of each other, and we also mark the birthday of our late son, Justin, who succumbed to cancer at age 18. Yet our tradition tells us to "be glad, it's Adar (which brings us Purim)!" and to begin the annual spiritual preparation for our Festival of Freedom, Passover; the gloom and despair will inevitably give way to celebration, hope, and the affirmations of life.

There is, indeed, much to celebrate in our Community: our new Torah Scroll is almost complete, thanks to your generosity and response to this exciting pro(Continued on page 4)

SISTERHOOD

The Sisterhood continues to meet every second Tuesday of the month at 10am at BSTC.

SOCIAL ACTION

The Social Action Committee is currently working on several initiatives, and we are inviting participation from Temple members.

• Sister Jose Women's Center, a Tucson-based

501(c)(3) non-profit organization aiding and transforming the lives of women who are unhoused. We are collecting donations of open/partially used full-sized shampoo, conditioner, body wash or liquid hand soap. We are also collecting donations of unopened travel-sized toiletries including deodorant, sunscreen, toothpaste and toothbrushes. Finally, we are collecting pet supplies, including kibble and dry cat food, kitty litter, and treats. These will be packaged in small bags and given to the women. All donations should be delivered to the Temple by March 31, 2024.

- Green Valley and Sahuarita Food Banks. We continue to collect food for our local food banks. Items most needed include peanut butter, cereal/oatmeal, macaroni and cheese, ramen, canned fruit, canned vegetables, canned beans, canned protein, rice, and pasta. There is a collection box in the Temple lobby.
- Project Angel Heart, a Tucson-based 501(c)(3)
 non-profit organization collecting new pajamas
 for foster children and other children in need.
 Larger-sized garments are most needed. In addition, new or gently used books are always welcomed. Again, a donation box is available in the Temple lobby.
